**"WHERE WE ARE IN PLACE AND TIME"
SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT**

The *"Where We Are in Place and Time"* unit culminated in a vibrant and engaging summative assessment. This theme encouraged students to explore concepts of identity, location, and connections within their world.

Students shared their understanding in creative ways. They presented self-made maps of their homes or schools, created models of landmarks, or told personal stories about routines and their surrounding environment. These activities demonstrated the students' growing spatial awareness, storytelling skills, and creative expression.

The assessment fostered interaction among students as they explored each other's projects, asked questions, and celebrated their achievements together. It concluded with reflections, where students reviewed what they accomplished, shared their favourite aspects of the project, and identified lessons learned for improvement.



IXL MATH

Early years students thoroughly enjoyed their IXL Math practice sessions, where they solved interactive exercises on computers and tablets. This engaging approach sparked excitement and motivation as students tackled digital math tasks.

IXL not only enhanced their problem-solving skills but also improved their English comprehension in mathematical contexts. Furthermore, it familiarized students with using technology—an essential skill in today's learning environment. The blend of play and learning made IXL a valuable tool for fostering both academic and digital skills. This past week, the students successfully completed their end-of-unit assessment.

SEMESTER 1 EXAMS

Students are preparing for their Semester 1 exams, scheduled for mid-December. This year, exams will follow a traditional format, with Grades 6-9 sitting simultaneously in an exam hall. Each grade will have a unique, level-appropriate exam. Invigilators, not teachers, will supervise the hall to ensure fairness and focus, following our invigilator policy. Students will receive clear behavior guidelines beforehand, promoting responsibility and discipline while preparing them for future academic experiences.
